MATERIALS LIST/FURTHER INFO FOR MOSAIC SESSIONS 2017

Tile cutters and a variety of adhesives will be supplied for use during the session.

Please bring your own base/object to mosaic on and medium (e.g. tiles, crockery, glass, specialty tiles, mirror and/or found items).

If you are new to mosaics it is advisable to discuss the suitability of your project and your materials with me prior to booking. Limited assistance with acquiring materials may be possible; however it is preferable that you bring your own materials.

Simpler projects include stepping stones and wall hangings/signs; using a consistent thickness of tiles or tessera as a medium on these is great for beginners.

Coloured tiles may be purchased from Elegance tiles in Wangaratta (Bunnings in Shepparton also has a selection of tiles). Vibrated Concrete Products in Benalla sell a great range of stepping stones/pavers. Most hardware stores have stepping stones/pavers and also sell board such as Ply, MDF and cement sheet. Specialty tiles may be purchased on line, www.themosaicstore.com.au has a good selection. You may also like to check out second- hand shops and garage sales for items to mosaic on or with.

Please also bring an old towel to cut into, safety glasses (or your usual glasses) and containers for loose pieces. As we will be using adhesives, it is advisable to wear an apron or suitable clothing. A cloth for wiping hands may be useful too. Gloves are not necessary; however you may prefer to use them.

This session does not include grouting; however a grouting session may be organised at a later date and will be discussed during the class.

You will be required to sign a workshop agreement and waiver form. A *parent/guardian must sign for participants **under 18** (please ensure this is done before the session commences)*. Children under 12 years should be accompanied by a parent/guardian.

Tea and coffee provided. There is also a microwave if required. Please book directly with me. Maximum 8 participants.
