Adam is an exciting, independent artist/designer who came out of the graffiti-art movement of the eighties. His blend of modern art and pop-culture with complex organic shapes make compelling works.

Over the past 25 years, Adam's creative journey has been inspired by people, places, events and ideas. His rich visual language is drawn from his surroundings of Melbourne's culture, however he has had very strong links and ties with Molyullah, near Benalla, since childhood.

Adam recently completed an artist in residency at St Vincent's Hospital.

Since the early 1990s, Adam has had four solo exhibitions and been in almost 30 group shows.

Adam has worked on several commissions for public, community and the private sectors. He has produced many public murals and much Street Art, most notably for The Project Underground at Emerald House, South Melbourne. His artworks have been featured on T.V Commercials, Pamphlets, Brochures, T-shirts, Skateboard Decks and Christmas Cards.

Adam has been the recipient of numerous awards including, first prize in the M.H.F poster competition 2015 and in Melbourne's Connected 10 exhibition in 2010. He received the People's Choice Award in the Connected 09 show held at the Victorian Arts Centre in 2009. His works are represented in a number of public and private collections, including St Vincent's Hospital and the Cunningham Dax.
