MATERIALS LIST FOR MOSAIC SESSIONS 2017

IF YOU HAVE SOME MOSAIC EXPERIENCE: Please bring your own base/object to mosaic on and medium (e.g. tiles, crockery, glass, specialty tiles, mirror and found items); an old towel, safety glasses (or your usual glasses), container/s for loose pieces. Contact me if you need instruction about pre-sealing bases.

BEGINNERS: Please bring your own base and ceramic tiles *preferably* as listed below. It is best not to bring crockery or glass for your first project. Great beginner projects are stepping stones or wall hangings/signs. We will seal bases at the start of the first session (or you can pre-seal if you wish).

- A clean paver or concrete stepping stone
OR
- Plywood/MDF board (for indoors or undercover areas) or cement sheet (for outdoors). Board should not flex and should be cut to the size you require. It's a good idea to think about how you will attach or hang the board to a wall/fence.
- Ceramic tiles – assorted colours. Any wall tiles will do of *reasonably consistent thickness*, including salvaged tiles (for a good selection of colours try Johnson wall tiles 10cm x 10cm available from Elegance Tiles Greta rd, Wangaratta. A smaller selection of colours is available from Bunnings – Shepparton. These tiles are usually around 85c each).

You will need enough tiles to cover your paver/board (extra is recommended especially for large areas of one colour such as backgrounds).

- An old towel and safety glasses (or your usual glasses)
- Container/s for loose tile pieces.

Please note:

No bookings are required. However, you may wish to contact me to discuss the suitability of new projects prior to your first session. Please inform me if you plan to attend an evening session.

As we will be using adhesives, it is advisable to wear an apron or suitable clothing.

Unfortunately we have limited storage space at NEA so mosaic projects (especially indoor mosaics) will need to be taken home at the end of each session. There may be some limited storage space available in a courtyard for larger outdoor items such as birdbaths. NEA does not accept responsibility for loss of or damage to projects or personal items.

You will be required to sign a workshop agreement and waiver form at the beginning of your first session but this will also cover any subsequent mosaic sessions at NEA. A parent/guardian must sign for anyone under 18. Please contact me to discuss at least 48hours in advance if you wish your child to attend a session unaccompanied.

These sessions do not include grouting; however grouting may be arranged at other times.
